

PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT

A Voter Registration Drive will be conducted from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm on the following dates and locations listed below:

- June 4th Santa Remedios Social Hall
- June 11th Kagman Community Center
- June 18th Carolinian Affairs Office
- June 20th Koblerville Youth Center
- June 25th San Vicente Youth Center

A person is eligible to vote who, on or before November 8, 2022, is 18 years of age or older, is a domiciled in the Commonwealth, has resided in the Commonwealth for 120 days prior to the day of the election, is not serving a sentence for a felony conviction, has not been declared by a court to be judicially insane, and is either a citizen or national of the United States as defined in the Northern Mariana Islands Constitution.

Previously registered voters who have failed to vote in the 2018 and 2020 General Election must re-register to be eligible to vote in the 2022 General Election. For first time voters, please provide a Valid US Passport or Birth Certificate.
